

## CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 - Compliance Notice.

"California Proposition 65," officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986. The proposition protects the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires companies to inform Californians about exposures to such chemicals.

This notice serves as SAVIO SpA's compliance statement for all globally supplied materials that may be placed in products sold in the state of California, and is based on information provided by our suppliers.

Specifically, the document "05-07-04 Notice Nickel Compounds" published by OEHHA mentions, "For purposes of clarification, OEHHA notes that nickel alloys are distinct from nickel compounds and are not included in the Proposition 65 list of nickel compounds. A nickel compound is a substance consisting of nickel and one or more other elements combined in defined proportions (e.g., by ionic or covalent bonds). A nickel alloy is a mixture of nickel with one or more other elements, typically produced by mixing molten nickel with other substances. The atoms in an alloy are not covalently or ionically bonded in fixed ratios."

Therefore, nickel in the steel alloys in our products is not on the list of substances included in "California Proposition 65"

Specifically, steel alloys "11SMnPb37" and "Pr80", as raw materials, contain lead in a maximum concentration of 0.35% by weight, and brass alloy "Ot58Pb" contains lead in a maximum concentration of 2.50% by weight

Cobalt, which may be present in steel as an impurity in very small amounts, is listed in the Proposition 65 List as a powder, which is not a relevant form for stainless steel alloy.

Please note that the products in question have not been developed, proposed, or accredited for applications requiring formulations to specifications for contact with drinking water.

Our company will continue to monitor for any new chemicals that will be included in the "Proposition 65 List"
